MOVING OF BUILDINGS

15.04.010 License and Bond Required

15.04.010 License and Bond Required. Any person before moving any building within the town limits shall:

(a) File with the town clerk a diagram of the route of the proposed move, together with the date and the approximate time of day such move is proposed to be made. Also, a statement showing in detail the method and equipment proposed to be used in such move, which must be approved by a properly designated representative of the town council before such move is made.

(b) File with the town clerk an undertaking in the penal sum of at least three hundred dollars (\$300.00), such amount to be set by the council in each individual case, to indemnify the town for any damage or injury incident to such move, such undertaking to be approved by the town council at its next regular meeting before a license will be issued; such undertaking not to be released until the full amount of such damage or injury, up to the full amount of such undertaking, shall have been paid, the council reserving the right of final inspection to determine whether such damage or injury has been fully repaired. Provided, however, that satisfactory evidence of liability insurance carried by the mover will be accepted in lieu of such undertaking.

(c) Pay a fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for such license. (Ord 46)
