9.11.010 Purpose: The purpose of this Code is to protect the rights of the citizens of Superior to move openly and freely on the town streets, sidewalks, and other public places without fear of being accosted by panhandlers.

9.11.020 Prohibiting Panhandling: No person shall obstruct or hinder passage on any street, sidewalk, or other public place within the town limits of the Town of Superior, Montana, by loitering in or about the same while begging money, food or clothing.

9.11.030 Penalty: A person convicted of panhandling shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and sentenced in accordance with section 1.08.010 general penalty of the Town of Superior Code.
